Dieses Teilgebiet des Stahlbaus wurde deshalb aus der bisherigen DIN EN 1090-2 herausgelöst und in die neue Teilnorm DIN EN 1090-4 überführt um mit der notwendigen Ausführlichkeit dargestellt zu werden. DIN EN 1090-4 wurde 2018 veröffentlicht und ist im vorliegenden Buch erstmalig kommentiert. Die aktuellen Fassungen beider Normteile im Volltext sind auf der dem Buch beigelegten CD-ROM enthalten. Die in der Voraufgabe von "Ausführung von Stahlbauten" ebenfalls kommentierte DIN EN 1090-1 ist in der Neuauflage nicht enthalten, da sie keine technischen Regeln für das Bauen, sondern ausschließlich Regeln für den formalen Konformitätsnachweis und die CE-Kennzeichnung des Bauproduktes "Tragende Stahlbauteile" enthält.
